What's 'Gyousei-ku' ?

As we live our daily life, we sometimes meet issues that the administration such as municipal office cannot provide full support to meet. The community association called "Gyousei-ku" is there for us to solve such problems. "Gyousei-ku" is placed in each district and works with the residents to strengthen their ties and to live comfortably.

What does Gyousei-ku do?

Activities to cleanup your local community.

In order to create a comfortable living environment, residents work together to clean up the neighborhood and conduct recycling activities, keep garbage collection spots clean.



Activities to provide local Information

• Distribute "Koho Ushiku" (the newsletter issued by City Hall) and pass around kairanban (the local bulletin) to share information with your neighbors.



Activities to prepare for emergency situations

You never know when a natural disaster occurs.
• Conduct disaster drills on a regular basis and stock emergency kit.



Activities to live safely and peacefully

• Traffic safety activities, including watch over elementary school children go to and from school.
• Conduct anticrime patrols.



Activities to organize social events

To get to know more people in your community, organize social events such as summer festival and athletic meets, and also traditional events.



Activities to expand the mutual support within the community

• Cooperate in social welfare activities as well as various fund-raising campaigns.
• Watch over single-living senior citizens.



♥ Other activities of 'Gyousei-ku'

'Kodomokai' which is a group aimed at communicating among parents and children.

'Senior Club' which is a group aimed at acting for health control or welfare for elder residents.



♥ What's an advantage to join Gyousei-ku ?

- You can get to know your neighbors by participating in 'Gyousei-ku' activities, and make your community livable with them.
- You can help each other at the time of disaster or emergency.
- Receive helpful community information that will make your life here better.



♥ How to join 'Gyousei-ku'

Ask a neighbor for the name and contact information for your 'Gyousei-ku' chairperson and call. Or call Ushiku City Hall Shimin Katsudouka-Division.
